There was one problem, Arnold's ice cream was so popular that he quickly ran out of paper bowls and customers began to leave for other treats.

In a booth close to Arnold's was Ernest Hamwi, who was selling Persian pastries called zalabias (though no one was buying them because of the heat). Seeing the problem and a possible solution, Hamwi twisted a zalabia into a cornucopia shape, rolled it in sugar and brought it to Arnold. Arnold didn't understand what was being proposed until Ernest dropped a scoop of ice cream on the zalabia and handed it to a customer. In no time at all, both men were working together selling World's Fair Cornucopias, which we know as one of my favorite treats: ice cream cones. Announcing a New Partnership for Ignite

Knowing this truth, we want to announce a new partnership with Multipliers Pathway. I had the opportunity to attend the initial training led by Multipliers last October in Raleigh, NC. The training was led by Todd Wilson and David Putman who have over 70 years of combined church planting and strategic planning experience. It was designed to help churches create an operating system fueled by disciple-making leading to multiplication of disciple-makers, groups and potentially, new churches.

I was impressed by the outcomes of the 6-month training process and Ignite's Board agreed that investing in this partnership could be a game-changer for our partner churches. We are partnering with Todd and David to bring the Multipliers Pathway training to Chicagoland starting in October 2025.

The training involves:

- A 6-month track: two in-person meetings and monthly 3-hour virtual sessions built around developing a multiplication plan
- A peer learning environment with other multiplying churches
- A collaborative environment for your key team (3 to 5 participants for each church)
- Tools for tuning up or installing a disciple-making engine

Partnering for World-wide Impact


